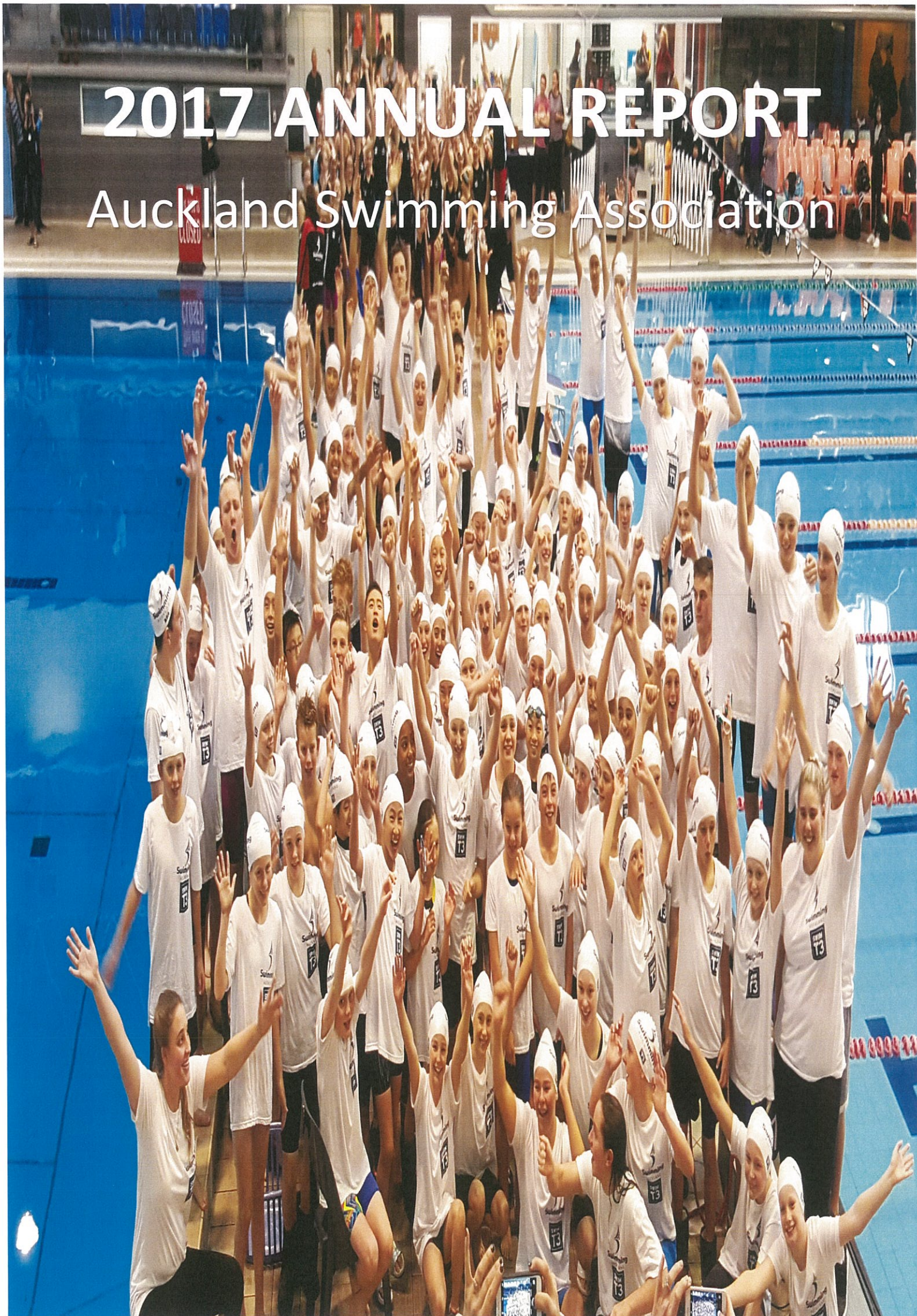

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2017

The recent announcement by Lauren Boyle to retire from competitive swimming will be a big loss to our sport. She has been heralded in the media as one of New Zealand's all-time best and leaves behind a legacy in the sport that includes a remarkable 14 medals at major international events. Lauren, thank you for your contribution to our sport and we wish you all the best for the future.

The rather mixed results in the pool at both the 2016 Rio Olympics and recent FINA World Championships implies that the limited high performance funding will be stretched further. This suggests that the Auckland region and our clubs will need to look into initiatives to keep our swimmers in the sport and provide them with opportunities to gain experience at international level with little impact on their own finances.

This will be of importance to our youth swimmers who showed their talent at the 2017 Youth Commonwealth Games held in the Bahamas in July. Of these swimmers the performances by Finn Kennard-Campbell should be mentioned for winning a Gold and a Bronze medal. Well done Finn!

Closer to home, the Harlequins team which includes a number of Auckland swimmers was successful in their defence as title holders of the Zonal Championships in February 2017. This event highlighted the all-round strength of the swimmers from the three Northern regions. The challenge will be to maintain this edge and to continue to build the strength of our Zone.

The Caro Cup competition which is now a regular feature on our swimming calendar was retained by the team from Auckland. Both Auckland and Waikato is in agreement that this competition should continue in future.

Again, we experienced success with our junior swim league which is continuing to grow. The success of this competition is due to the efforts of both the Central City and Mount Roskill swim clubs. The challenge for the future is to expand this competition format to other areas in our region. This competition provides a fun-filled introduction to swimming and is conducive to growing the sport at junior level

Congratulations to all the swimmers of the teams mentioned above as well as their coaches!

In 2016/17 some of our volunteers were recognised for the time they contribute to our sport. A warm congratulations to John West for receiving a Swimming New Zealand Life Membership award. This is well deserved. Congratulations also to Teresa Stanley, our past chair, and Thomas Ansorg for receiving a Swimming New Zealand Service award. The Board and I wish to acknowledge all the work and hours put in by all our other volunteers. The success of our sport depends on your efforts.

The success of our competitions depends on having reliable equipment. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and funding partners Auckland Swimming was able to, amongst other initiatives maintain and replace our equipment. Thanks to funding received from The Trusts, plans are already in place for the replacement of the scoreboard at West Wave



within the coming months. The Auckland Board wishes to thank The Trusts for including us in their Million Dollar Mission as well as for all the members who voted for us. We are sure that everybody will reap the reward of this initiative.

The Board alone cannot govern the region and we do rely on our working groups. The outcomes of our working groups will be experienced in 2018 with the implementation of our competition programme. On behalf of the Board I would like to thank you for your contribution and service to the swimming community.

Our staff, Brett as Chief Executive Officer together with Kate in her role as Office Manager, have been integral in the delivery of services to the Auckland Swimming community in the past year. The status of financials and services to the clubs to mention a couple reflect the work you have put in. Your dedication goes well beyond the norm of expectations for the good of our sport.

Lastly, I would acknowledge the effort and hard work of my fellow board members; Sandra Burrow, Claudia Hill, Flo Hickey and our President Shirley Mackay. Your enthusiasm and efforts are appreciated.

CEO REPORT 2017

What a great year! 211 records have been set by Auckland swimmers at National and/or Regional level. That's 71 more than last year. Our club membership numbers are growing and we welcomed back the Onehunga Club into the ASA family. We are excited about the upcoming season.

GOVERNANCE and MANAGEMENT

The Board and the Office have had a productive year and are continually looking at refining our processes and working smarter not harder. Suggested changes to our constitution are a result of this. I would like to thank the Board for their dedication, commitment and open mindedness to look at things a little differently at times.

Kate continues to do an exceptional job of keeping our office running smoothly and efficiently. We have started on a new Strategic Plan and will be seeking feedback from members in the near future.

The overhaul of the Incorporated Societies Act (1908) is underway and will be introduced into Parliament for its first reading and Select Committee next year. While the updated Act is at least 4 years away from coming into law, it is prudent for clubs to be working on updating their constitutions as they often take a lot longer than expected. I would encourage all clubs that have not updated their constitutions in recent years to begin the process as soon as possible.

FINANCE

While it is good to be in a position of not having to rely on Grants for day to day operations, having money in the bank does make it more difficult to access grants for non-discretionary spending. It is a fine balance which is working well for us at the present.

MEETS

Our meets are going well and the CSG works hard to keep them up to date and relevant. The 2018 Calendar is a reflection of this. While it is not yet 'public' due to some final tweaking needed around bookings at Westwave, I believe we are now heading in a much more sustainable direction in terms of resources, personnel and relevance to the swimmers i.e. putting the right meets at the right time.

League continues to grow and with its simplified structure and focus at school level, we are delivering a fun introduction to our sport that is already attracting new members. A huge thanks to Central City and Roskill Clubs for their tireless efforts in reinvigorating this.

The Caro Cup saw the addition of 13 year old teams. Next year we will add 14 year olds and cap it there. Talks are in progress a round a senior competition for 2018.

Being Host Region for the majority of National meets continues to put added pressure on our Officials and volunteers. However it is a necessary part of what we do and also a good income stream. As the biggest Region, having enough people help out should not be an issue and it is embarrassing for us when this is regularly not the case. We need to be taking a more holistic view so that we can support and resource our all our swimmers.

Our Technical Group has continued to provide amazing support and resource to upskilling and increasing our officials' base. We have seen good growth in the number of qualified IOT's. However we are still vulnerable in the Senior Officials area (JOS and above). We only need a



couple of retirements and our ability to deliver ratified meets will be severely limited. Clubs need to be proactive in encouraging their parents to 'give it a go'.

The Events Group is an essential component to our meets. They do an awesome job and give oversight to the many things that need to happen for the event to run smoothly. It is a small group that is in dire need of more help and support. This is an opportunity to get parents more involved particularly those that don't want to go down the official's path.

TECHNOLOGY

With the new scoreboard ready for installation, backstroke start ledges on order and 2 more touch pads due by the end of the year we are nearly at the completion of our refurbishment.

The Technology Group reprioritised the scoreboard as our most urgent need and with the generosity and support of Panasonic and The Trusts this has been achieved with little impact on cash flow. This makes upgrading our timing system from Ares to Quantum in 2018 our last big ticket item. Our Technology Group works wonders with what is a very old and often temperamental beast.

If our Senior Officials are vulnerable then our AOD Team is on the endangered list. They carry a huge work load and a tremendous responsibility for both ASA and National meets simply because of their small team. Many hands make light work and it is imperative that clubs ensure that they have their own personnel capable of working and supporting in this area. The upgrade to Quantum will make things a lot easier but it will still need humans to operate it.

RELATIONSHIPS

Recent major changes of personnel both at Westwave and SNZ are requiring us rebuild and re-establish a number of key relationships. This will take time, understanding and patience.

WEST WAVE

As our 'home-base' we are needing to change the way we do things. The facility is under huge user pressure and we can no longer assume that we will have carte blanche access.

The number of meets and their placement on the calendar, timings of sessions, sharing with other users e.g. diving, H&S etc. are all factors that we are working through at the moment. In essence the way we have traditionally done things will no longer work for us or the facility and we will need to adapt. While the changes may not be radical, they will involve compromise and breaking away from 'what we have always done.' Change is good but it can also be hard and unsettling.

Finally I would like to acknowledge all the members of our Working Groups, Officials and Volunteers without whom we would not be able to function. You are selfless with your time and energy and on behalf of the Auckland Swimming community I say 'thank you, thank you, thank you.'
