Meet Conditions:

1. Age as at day of the meet, 3 March 2019.
2. This meet will be conducted under SNZ rules and the local conditions listed. No time trials permitted. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
3. No swimmer may have achieved an ASA Level 1 or Level 2 time. All times to be SC, or best LC converted to SC.
4. All events time finals, mixed girls & boys, graded scratch, results declared on times.
5. Entries **\$5.00 per individual event**. (Events 8 & 16 are free.) Late entries (**\$10.00 per event**) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane. No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
6. Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply. Reseeding or combining of heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
7. The ASA Disqualification Criteria and Guidelines for Level 3 Meets will be applied. As a result, the organisers will not be seeking SNZ Approval for this meet.
8. Poolside Officials: ASA will endeavour to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirement set out in SNZ rules. **Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers. Teams must ensure minimum supervision of 2 adults (coach and team manager) per 12 swimmers entered. No photography is permitted on pool deck during the swim meet unless prior permission has been obtained from the Meet Controller.
