MEET CONDITIONS:

- **5 Event Entry Restriction.**
- Swimming New Zealand and Local Rules apply.
- Age as at the day of the meet.
- Age Groups – 10 & under, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & over.
- Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall in each age group, male and female.
- **Entries \$8.00 per event.**
- Late entries \$15.00 (only if there is a spare lane) at the discretion of the Meet Organizer.
- No refunds on scratching once psych sheets are posted, unless a Medical Certificate is sighted within 48 hours of meet end.
- ‘Over the top’ and ‘One Start’ rule apply.
- Reseeding or combining of heats will be at the referee’s discretion.
- All events graded scratch races, results declared on times.
- Swimmers must have achieved a ASA Level 2 qualifying time in at least 1 event.
- No Time entries will be accepted. Custom times will be accepted from clubs.
- No time trials permitted.
- **Entries via the Swimming New Zealand Database.**
- **Entries close 11.59pm Wednesday 17th October 2018.**

- Clubs to supply 1 official per 4 swimmers per session. For every 8 swimmers per session you must include a Qualified TK and IOT or JOS. Please supply workers list to Meet Controller by 19th October 2018.
- All participants must agree to comply with Sports Anti-doping rules.
- Poolside Officials: ASA will endeavor to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirements set out in the SNZ Rules.
- Only swimmers, officials, coaches and authorised team managers to be pool deck.

- **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ASA TECH SUIT RESTRICTION POLICY APPLIES TO ALL 12/U SWIMMERS.**

Health and safety is everyone’s responsibility.

Coaches and/or team managers are responsible for their teams and are expected to enforce any rules and regulations of the meet, the facility provider, ASA & SNZ. Prior to entering swimmers, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient skill, experience and an understanding of safety to enter. Coaches must assess the health of their swimmers prior to, on the day of and during the event and withdraw swimmers who are injured or unwell. Teams must ensure minimum supervision of 2 adults (coach and team manager) per 12 swimmers entered.
