The league is a FUN, TEAM SWIMMING COMPETITION designed to introduce swimming
as a TEAM SPORT to the New Zealand EDUCATION SYSTEM and to
CREATE an AWARENESS of WATER SAFETY to Primary and Intermediate pupils.

Every School that participates will receive a school visit from the DROWING PREVENTION EDUCATION OFFICERS who will give a VIDEO PRESENTATION and TALK on "WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A WATER EMERGENCY" to every year group in the school.

HOW PRIMARY AND INTERMEDIATE SWIM LEAGUE WORKS:

- ◆ School league operates in Terms 2 and 3 of the school year.
- ◆ There are 5 rounds of competition each term
- ◆ Each round is approximately 35 - 40 minutes long
- ◆ Dates for Term 3, 2019 -

- ◆ Primary School League - year 5/under and year 6
- ◆ Intermediate League - years 7 and 8
- ◆ Team Sizes and Events:

Teams of between 8 (minimum) and 20 (Maximum) compete in individual races (25m each of Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, and Butterfly), plus Relay races (Freestyle, Medley, a Grand Relay, and a Survival Relay organised by Drowning Prevention Auckland).
- ◆ Teams can be mixed, all female, or all male.
- ◆ Minimum swimming skills, for swimmer participation - to be able to swim one length of a 25 m pool for the stroke entered.
- ◆ Cost per team is \$250.00
- ◆ If your school is new to the league competition, Auckland Swimming can provide coaching assistance and help with managing your team.

Team Size:

Minimum team size will be 8 swimmers (4 males and 4 females) up to a Maximum of 20 swimmers, i.e. 2-5 girls, 2-5 boys of each year.

Events: (Same programme each week.)

4 Individual (each age group male and female)

50 Freestyle

25 Backstroke

25 Breaststroke

25 Butterfly

4 Mixed Relay events (each age group)

Freestyle Relay. 4 swimmers – first 3 swim 25m 4th swimmer swims 50m

Medley Relay 4 x 25m

Grand Relay 8 x 25m (2 swimmers each age group, male and female (freestyle))

Intermediate School League

Categories:

Year 7 and Year 8 Boys and Girls

Team Size:

Minimum team size will be 8 swimmers (4 males and 4 females) up to a Maximum of 20 swimmers, i.e. 2-5 girls, 2-5 boys of each year.

Events: (Same programme each week.)

4 Individual (each age group male and female)

50 Freestyle

25 Backstroke

25 Breaststroke

25 Butterfly

4 Mixed Relay events (each age group)

Freestyle Relay. 4 swimmers – first 3 swim 25m 4th swimmer swims 50m

Drowning Prevention Auckland Relay 5 x 25m

Medley Relay 4 x 25m

Grand Relay 8 x 25m (2 swimmers each age group, male and female (freestyle))

Note:

If teams are short of either boys or girls they may swim each other's events.

ASA Primary and Intermediate Schools League

Rules specific to the ASA Primary and Intermediate Schools League

1. All swimsuits must be fabric. No wetsuits permitted
2. All swimmers must be registered with the ASA Primary and Intermediate School's League in order to be eligible to swim in a Final, and must have swum in at least one preceding round.
3. A swimmer may swim in an unlimited number of relays in their own or higher category.
4. Classification for ASA Primary and Intermediate Leagues will be made based on the swimmer's school year from one of these four categories i.e. Year 5 and under, Year 6, Year 7 and Year 8.
5. Placings for each event will be determined by timekeeper's sheets using the middle time for three manual timings on each lane (where available) or the average of two timings on each lane (where available)
6. The session Referee's decision will be final.
7. In addition to each team having a team manager, every team will supply three timekeepers (who will be assigned a lane other than their teams lane) and one administration assistant per session
8. There will be no marshalling. Team Managers are responsible for ensuring that swimmers are available at the start of each event. The start of events will not be delayed
9. Team Manager's Sheets must be made available to Admin
10. Points allocation will be made in accordance with the published schedule.
11. Technical infringements as determined by the Referee will result in relegation to last place for that event (and corresponding points score for that event)
12. For the avoidance of doubt, unless a matter is covered under ASA Primary and Intermediate Schools League Rules, the Referee will use the rules of the ASA (Auckland Swimming Association)
13. If teams are short of either boys or girls they may swim each other's events.
